Your guide Wirecutter Staff Share this review Though the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the American Red Cross, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention all provide emergency supply checklists, those lists can be intimidating in their breadth and their specificity.

In reality, for the most part you can assemble an emergency kit out of stuff you'd use anyway and may already own. There's never a bad time to prepare for a crisis by stocking up on gear and organizing it so you know exactly where it is when you need it most. We did 120 hours of research and tested nearly 100 different products to come up with 31 products that will be indispensable in case of a natural disaster—and helpful in everyday life, too. In addition to about 20 other pieces of gear that would be useful in any disaster scenario, we've also outlined a few important considerations to keep in mind for specific disasters such as earthquakes, hurricanes, and wildfires. Of course, disaster prep is about more than just buying stuff. Develop a simple communication plan with your family so you know where to meet and who to call ideally, someone out of state if power and cell service go down. Evacuation during the coronavirus pandemic The COVID19 pandemic requires new levels of preparedness to stay safe if you have to evacuate to a shelter in a disaster scenario. Knowing what to expect ahead of time—and what's expected of you—goes a long way toward protecting everyone and keeping these vital spaces operating safely. FEMA has a guide to state emergency agencies and their websites, but there is no one central database broken down by all states and their county offices. Frankly, most stategovernment websites are so hard to navigate that our best advice to find information locally is to just Google your county and state name along with "emergency management" to see specifics for your area. One certainty, in any location, will be a need for more shelter staff than in past disasters. Willing to help out in your area. The American Red Cross is always looking for volunteers. If you need to evacuate to a shelter in 2020, here are the key procedural changes, as outlined by FEMA, to know about Masks will be required Masks and other forms of PPE personal protective equipment such as hand sanitizer and gloves will be in use.

You're encouraged to bring your own if possible as part of a gokit, but supplies should be available, either directly through your local emergency management office or a volunteer organization like the Red Cross. Given how polarizing masks have become, there's a real risk of someone causing a scene at a shelter entrance and holding up the line to get in, or putting people in danger once inside. Emergency managers we spoke to for our Best Hurricane Preparedness Supplies and Strategies guide said that these would have to be dealt with on a casebycase basis. Jonathan McNamara, a regional communications manager for the Red Cross, told us, "Every one of our Red Cross volunteers go through frontline psychological training to help have difficult conversations. It's some of the most important work that we do. I suspect that will be more important this year maybe than in the past." Shelters will open earlier for health screenings, and if you're sick, you'll be segregated or moved Temperature checks and health screenings will be administered before you're allowed inside, so shelters will open earlier to avoid congestion. If you're running a temperature or not feeling well, expect to be segregated from the general population or moved to another shelter entirely. Your normal location may have changed Due to social distancing requirements, some shelters can't hold as many people, and new locations are being designated to handle the spread. Yet another reason to pay close attention to your local emergency management office. And say bon voyage to the buffet—when provided, food will now come prepackaged. About preassembled kits The easiest way to feel prepared for an emergency is to go to your local bigbox store and pick up a readymade emergency kit. Unfortunately, after studying the contents of a dozen such kits online and getting four to rip apart in person, we can say with certainty that none of them are worth your money.

But the key safety gear you need—a radio, a flashlight, and a firstaid kit—were universally of poor quality, far inferior to our picks of the Midland ER210 emergency radio and the Black Diamond Spot

325 headlamp, for instance. Many kits contained products we know are no good, like cheap collapsible water containers, junky multitools, and offbrand duct tape. Meanwhile, the gritty, blocklike food bars weren't anything you'd want to eat unless you were actually on the verge of starving to death. Even in a bad guake or a onceinadecade storm, you'd be better off with a big jug of water and a handful of granola bars or energy bars. In this case, size does matter. The cheap, bundled radios from the preassembled kits right just couldn't compete with our original pick from Midland left in loudness, reception, or features. Certainly, having a premade bag is a lot better than having nothing. But for the money, it won't be half as good as a kit that you assemble yourself with careful consideration of your own family's needs in mind. -Kalee Thompson Water "You can never have enough water when a disaster happens," said Jeff Edelstein, who spun SOS Survival Products off from his dad's California hardware store 25 years ago. FEMA recommends a threeday supply—a gallon per person per day. That's generally enough to cover drinking water and basic hygiene needs. If you're caught unprepared, know that the typical home water heater contains 32 gallons of potable water. The water in your toilet tank, which is replaced after each flush, is also generally safe to drink. But ideally, you won't have to resort to that. We think FEMA's threeday recommendation is unreasonably modest—especially for people in earthquake country. Scientists fear that a massive rupture along the San Andreas Fault could damage the agueducts and pipelines that deliver water to Southern California, and that "repairs may take weeks to 6 months or more." The dreaded Cascadia megaguake in the Pacific Northwest could also leave millions of people without services for months or longer. We've seen that floods and hurricanes like Katrina and Sandy can cause massive utility disruptions and contamination of municipal water supplies. Given those risks, and the relative ease of storing water, we think that stockpiling a 10 to 14day supply is a reasonable goal if you live in an earthquake zone. The doityourself—and free—option is to fill old soda bottles with tap water. Avoid using recycled milk or juice containers, which are more likely to harbor bacteria. The easiest and best way to ensure an adequate and easily transportable water supply is to get some dedicated containers. --KT Water storage Our pick Reliance AquaTainer 7 gallons Our pick for one or two people This sturdy, 7gallon plastic jug is ideal for storing emergency water for one person or using as a vessel to move and pour water stored in a larger drum. Rigid water containers made of blue polyethylene consistently perform better than opaque collapsible ones for both storage they offer more durability and leak resistance, and prevent bacterial growth and pouring. We surveyed the field of large, rigid plastic water jugs and called in five models for testing before concluding that the oversize, rugged, 7gallon Reliance AquaTainer is the best overall choice for disasterpreparedness purposes, and car camping trips as well. The AquaTainer left was easier to use and able to prevent spills better than any other jug we tested. The 7gallon AquaTainer was the biggest of the containers we looked at; the field also included two different 5gallon Reliance models, the 5gallon Coleman Water Carrier, and the 3.5gallon WaterBrick.

Its largerthanmost size provides a full week's worth of water for one person. Unlike the Reliance WaterPak and the WaterBrick, the AquaTainer has a builtin breakproof handle that is relatively comfortable to use. As with many Reliance products—including all three we tested—the spigot is stored inside the cap when not in use, reducing the risk of cracking or smashing. The Coleman container's standard spigot lacks this feature, and the WaterBrick does not have a spigot at all. The AquaTainer is the only one of the three Reliance jugs we looked at with a tethered, screwon airvent valve—meaning no tiny parts to lose and no accidental leakage in transport. Finally, the AquaTainer is a better value than 5gallon models made by the same company. The company introduced a new spigot design An added plastic "skirt" ring ensures that the threading on the cap lines up perfectly with the threading on the container. Reliance containers have a fiveyear warranty, so buyers who have encountered subpar spigots can request a free replacement by contacting Reliance customer

service at 8006650258 or through this contact page. So you can keep it in your cart until you're ready to order or just get a new jug if it's more cost effective. The new spigots have a thicker tap with "O" and "I" markings for open and closed, labels absent on the older designs. A couple of caveats Unlike some other Reliance models, the AquaTainer is not designed to be stacked. When full, the 7gallon jug weighs close to 60 pounds. The 5gallon Reliance AquaPak, which is usually a few dollars more, may be a better choice for people who lack muscle, or who envision lugging water long distances. Or you could just buy the bigger, cheaper jug and avoid filling it to the brim. Reliance officially advises that users replace emergency water stored in its containers every 90 days, a recommendation the company says was inspired by FEMA's guidelines.

But if you wash your hands vigorously before filling the jug to avoid contaminating the water with bacteria, and if you keep it sealed, there's no reason why you can't store water in the jug for a year before refreshing it, according to waterguality scientist Max Gyllenskog PDF. If you do abide by sanitary conditions, you don't need to treat tap water before storing, but if you're concerned about contamination you can use regular household bleach or a water purification tablet to treat your water when you're ready to use it. --KT Our pick Augason Farms 55Gallon Water Storage Barrel Our pick for more than two people This large drum made of foodgrade plastic allows you to store an entire family's supply of water for five years before refreshing. While the Reliance AquaTainer's size is a good fit for a one or twoperson household, a family of four would need eight of those jugs to store a twoweek supply of water. A more economical and ultimately more convenient option is to purchase a 55gallon drum, like this one from Augason Farms. Whether you choose to treat your water when you put it in the drum or when you take it out, tap water sealed tight in a dedicated water drum like this can last for at least five years. Augason Farms also sells an Emergency Water Storage Supply Kit, which comes with all the accessories you need to store and later use water, such as a siphon hose, a hand pump, and a liquid water purifier made of chlorine dioxide which works fine, as does simply adding. When prices spike, you might consider buying the drum and components separately. In our experience, most blue 55gallon drums of this type are essentially the same.
